SPECIAL PROGRAMS AT CITY BALLET

THE PROFESSIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM

The Professional Training Program is designed for students that want to make optimum progress by providing them with the ability to take unlimited classes (Levels Yellow and above). Students are mentored as they prepare for a dance career, higher education, or if they just enjoy the challenge of achieving their personal best. PTP students can take up to 22 hours per week, including all required classes listed for their level plus Modern Repertoire, Studio Company, or City Ballet company.

Students that sign up for the PTP program will have the opportunity to choose the additional classes they would like to add to their schedule beginning August 19th

YOUTH BALLET ENSEMBLE and CONTEMPORARY (Modern/ Jazz Techniques with Stretch/ Flexibility)

Youth ballet ensembles are a vital part of the City Ballet School and Company, allowing students the ability to receive additional class time that is critical for Yellow and Green levels. Students learn important elements of performing, especially working together toward the achievement of a shared artistic goal. As the future City Ballet company, these students work alongside company members in each City Ballet performance and build their skills through many exciting performance opportunities.

CITY BALLET STUDIO COMPANY, COMPANY, AND MODERN REPERTOIRE COMPANY

The most highly acclaimed ballet company in the area, City Ballet **Studio Company** and **Company** members perform a wide variety of full-length ballets, plus other classical and contemporary repertoire. Working with professional guest artists, ballet répétiteurs and choreographers, City Ballet dancers work at the highest level with life-enhancing performance opportunities.

City Ballet's **Modern Repertoire Co.** specializes in modern dance styles which are current with today's professional dance companies. The Modern Repertoire Company has performed "Picture of Dorian Gray" and "Tittle Tattle" at The Wilson Center in May 2018 and 2019 and will continue to work on new contemporary repertoire each season.

Students in both the ballet and modern companies are expected to perform for the 2019-2020 Full Season and must take at least 4 hours of ballet technique and pointe classes in addition to the performing companies (2 class days per week - they have the flexibility to choose any two class days M-F).

FULL SESSION TUITION AND FEES

To register and reserve your spot in classes, you pay the first monthly tuition installment as your deposit (before July 15th for continuing students). This is non-refundable (tuition installment information listed below).

IMPORTANT: Continuing students must register by July 15th (after July 15th a \$50 Registration Fee is applied).

Monthly Tuition Installments (Tuition is divided into 10 Monthly Installments)

The Full Session consists of 34 weeks of instruction from August 26, 2019 to May 30, 2020.

To Register: The 1st of 10 monthly tuition installments must be paid to complete your registration

August 1, 2019: The Performing Materials Fee is due with registration (see PAF below).

Following the 1st tuition installment, there are 9 installments for each month from September 2019 through May 2020, billed automatically on the first of each month.

Costumes provided for ALL students

Tuition Assistance is available for qualified students and families.

- Family Tuition Cap – monthly tuition will not exceed \$550 per household
- Male Scholarship – 25% - Full tuition discount (contact Andrea Hill for info)

10% Family Discount - applied to each additional member (of the same family).

One-Time Registration Fee (REG) –

New students and Continuing students that have not registered by July 15th

\$50 per student, maximum \$100 per family. This fee is paid only once when a student or family first registers at the City Ballet (students must register for subsequent Full Sessions before July 1, 2018). This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Performing Activities Fee (PAF) – Due August 1st

This fee helps defray school and company performing costs for the year (2 to 3 fully staged performances) including auditorium rental, scenery, music licensing, etc. **Costumes are provided free of charge for all students.** There are no costumes to purchase, no recital or competition fees, and no required fund raising.

Yellow, Green (Groups A, B, C with Youth Ballet Ensemble):	\$200/ Full Session
Green (Groups D and E), Aqua, Blue, Indigo and Violet-Gold:	\$300/ Full Session
