## **SPECIAL PROGRAMS AT CITY BALLET**

### **BOY'S PERFORMANCE ENSEMBLE (Ages 9-14+)**

The Boy's Performance Ensemble provides boys with the opportunity to perform with the City Ballet Company in *A Carolina Nutcracker* and other performances throughout the season. Boys learn important fundamentals of dance training/ strengthening that will benefit them in many areas of life – dance, sports, theater, etc. The strong values of discipline, respect, perseverance is combined with the physical benefits of strength, balance, coordination and flexibility. The boys enjoy the challenges of class and the excitement of rehearsals and performance!

Boys younger than age 9 may take any classes for their age and level. They will have the opportunity to join the Boy's Performance Ensemble for performances, and are invited to join the ensemble when ready.

### **THE PROFESSIONAL TRAINING PROGRAM**

The Professional Training Program is designed for students that want to make optimum progress by providing them with the ability to take unlimited classes. Students are mentored as they prepare for a dance career, for higher education, or if they just enjoy the challenge of achieving their personal best. PTP students take from 10 to 21 hours per week, including all required classes listed for their level plus Modern Repertoire, Studio Company, or City Ballet company.

### **YOUTH BALLET ENSEMBLE I and II**

### **YELLOW and GREEN LEVELS**

Youth ballet ensembles are a vital part of the City Ballet School and Company, allowing students the ability to receive additional class time that is critical for Yellow and Green levels. Students learn important elements of performing, especially working together toward the achievement of a shared artistic goal. As the future City Ballet company, these students work alongside company members in each City Ballet performance and build their skills through many exciting performance opportunities.

### **CITY BALLET STUDIO COMPANY, COMPANY, AND MODERN REPERTOIRE COMPANY**

The most highly acclaimed ballet company in the area, City Ballet **Studio Company** and **Company** members perform a wide variety of full-length ballets, plus other classical and contemporary repertoire. Working with professional guest artists, ballet répétiteurs and choreographers, City Ballet dancers work at the highest level with life-enhancing performance opportunities.

City Ballet's **Modern Repertoire Co.** specializes in modern dance styles which are current with today's professional dance companies. The Modern Repertoire Company recently performed "Picture of Dorian Gray" at The Wilson Center in May 2018 and will continue to work on new contemporary repertoire this season.

Students in both the ballet and modern companies are expected to perform for the 2018-2019 Full Season and must take at least 4 hours of ballet technique and pointe classes in addition to the performing companies (2 class days per week – they have the flexibility to choose any two class days M-F).

**FULL SESSION TUITION AND FEES**

**The Full Session consists of 33 weeks of instruction from August 27, 2018 to May 19, 2019.**

*Continuing students must register by July 1<sup>st</sup> (after July 1<sup>st</sup> a \$50/ students new students Registration Fee will be applied).*

**To register and reserve your spot in classes, you will make a deposit consisting of the 1<sup>st</sup> of 10 monthly tuition installments (before July 1<sup>st</sup> for continuing students).**

Following the Deposit, there are 9 installments for each month from September 2018 through May 2019, billed automatically on the first of each month. The Performing Materials Fee is due August 1<sup>st</sup> (see PAF below).

**Costumes provided for ALL students**

- Tuition Assistance available for qualified students and families.

**One-Time Registration Fee (REG)**

\$50 per student, maximum \$100 per family. This fee is paid only once when a student or family first registers at the City Ballet (students must register for subsequent Full Sessions before July 1, 2018). This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

**Performing Activities Fee (PAF) – Due August 1<sup>st</sup>**

This fee helps defray school and company performing costs for the year (2 to 3 fully-staged performances) including auditorium rental, scenery, music licensing, etc. **Costumes are provided free of charge for all students.** There are no costumes to purchase, no recital or competition fees, and no required fund raising.

Pre-Ballet, Pink, Red, Orange: **\$150/ year**

Yellow - Youth Ballet Ensemble I: **\$200/year**

Green through Gold – Youth Ballet Ensemble II, Studio Company, Company: **\$300/ year**
